

EAA Chapter 42-Minutes from 9/01/2010 meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by John Davis.

Lars Gleitsmann moved to accept Dick Reeve's resignation as EAA Chapter 42 president, the motion was seconded by Mike Kelly.

Lars then made a motion to move Bob Edison from vice president to president of the Chapter until new elections later this fall. Rob Stapleton seconded the motion.

Old Business-

Treasurer John Davis reported that the EAA Chapter 42 bank account had \$3,452.29 the report was moved for acceptance by webmaster Walter Yankauskas after John showed receipt for \$373.13 for the summer BBQs. Stapleton passed around the Aug. minutes from the last EAA 42 BOD meeting that were passed after a motion by John Davis and seconded by Walter Y unanimously.

New Business-

Jon Davis read the bylaws and suggested we bring it up at an upcoming meeting.

Stapleton suggested that we bring up the topic of volunteering at the museum as they need help with the Pilgrim.
